

WTS Will Kempton High School Scholarship

WTS fosters the development of women and girls in the transportation field by encouraging bright new professionals and students to undertake careers in the area of transportation. One way it does this is by awarding scholarships to girls pursuing high school studies in science, technology, engineering, and math.

The WTS Sacramento Chapter Will Kempton High School Scholarship in the amount of \$2,000 is available to a female high school senior in the Sacramento Region who is inspired to pursue a college degree in a transportation-related field, including studies in engineering, math, architecture, geography, business, law, political science, environmental science, planning, economics, sociology, and government policy. The scholarship is named for the former Director of the California Department of Transportation who serves as a strong advocate for WTS and the importance of education.

WTS Sacramento will forward the application of the local recipient of this scholarship for entrance in the national level scholarship selection process. At the national level, the Will Kempton High School Scholarship is awarded as the WTS Transportation YOU High School Scholarship in the amount of \$2,500. The minimum criteria for selection are:

- a. Applicant must be a high school senior
- b. GPA of 3.0 or higher
- c. Currently studying math, science, and technology
- d. Considering a college degree in a transportation-related field

Each application must be submitted through WTS Sacramento as a **single, typed PDF** file. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation goals, academic record, and transportation-related activities or job skills. **The WTS Sacramento Chapter Will Kempton High School Scholarship recipient will receive \$2,000 from the Sacramento Chapter and will be presented with their award at the Annual Award & Scholarships Event in January 2024.**

Applicants are encouraged to apply for multiple applicable WTS Sacramento Scholarships; however, our chapter will award only one scholarship per Applicant.

National awards will be presented during the WTS Annual Conference in May 2024. Recipients of the national awards will be notified in early spring 2024.
