

WTS Junior College/Trade School Scholarship

WTS fosters the development of women in the transportation field by encouraging bright new professionals to undertake careers in the area of transportation. One way it does this is by awarding community, technical, or trade college scholarships to women pursuing transportation-related study at community and trade colleges.

This scholarship is intended for students pursuing an associate or technical degree in transportation-related studies.

The WTS Junior College/Trade School Scholarship is awarded at the local and international level. The WTS Sacramento Chapter will award \$2,000 to the local recipient. WTS Sacramento will then forward the application of the local recipient of this scholarship for entrance in the national level scholarship selection process. The national award is in the amount of \$2,500. The minimum criteria for selection are:

- a. GPA of 3.0 or higher
- b. Currently enrolled in a degree program in a transportation-related field
- c. Plans to pursue a career in a transportation-related field

Applications must be submitted through WTS Sacramento as a single, typed PDF file. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Scholarships are competitive and based on the applicant's specific transportation goals, academic record, and transportation-related activities or job skills. The WTS Sacramento Chapter Junior College/Trade School Scholarship recipient will receive \$2,000 from the Sacramento Chapter and will be presented with their award at the Annual Award & Scholarships Event in January 2024.

Recipients of the national awards will be notified in early spring 2024. National awards will be presented during the WTS Annual Conference in May 2024.
